A \$100 rebate will be allowed for every bull taken into purchaser's possession on sale day on bulls that bring \$2000 or more. Bulls that remain in seller's possession will be fed free of charge until April 1, 2009 and at that time purchases totaling \$5000 or more will be delivered in Nebraska and neighboring states free of charge. Purchases totaling under \$5000 can be delivered to central points for no more than \$200 per head. The purchaser is responsible for the bull at the end of the auction even if not in their possession. All purchasers are encouraged to obtain insurance on their bulls following the sale.

If a bull proves to be a non-breeder, a satisfactory exchange will be made either in a replacement bull or credit at the 2011 sale. A complaint must be made by September 1, 2010.
